5 January 2, 2007 at 7:00 p.m.

7 Meeting was called to order by Vice Mayor DiRemigio.

9 City Clerk called the roll and the following council persons were in attendance: Vice Mayor
10 DiRemigio, Cunningham, Haynes, Wallace and Wood. Absent: Lemasters and Simms. Also
11 present: City Manager Hendershot, Police Chief Kudlak, Fire Chief Clarke, Street Commissioner
12 Richmond, Building Inspector Wise, Attorney Thomas White and City Clerk Hewitt. Absent:
13 CPA Thomas Dobbs.

17 **Regular Council Meeting of December 19, 2006.**

19 Councilperson Wood made a motion to accept and approve the minutes of the regular council
20 meeting of December 19, 2006, seconded by Councilperson Haynes. Motion carried
21 unanimously.

23 **GENERAL PUBLIC HEARING:**

25 * David White, 406 Clinton Avenue, asked when the traffic light was going to be fixed at Fourth
26 Street & Cedar Avenue. Manager Hendershot advised that parts have been ordered.

30 * Vice Mayor DiRemigio wished to welcome Fourth Ward Councilperson Jack Cunningham.

34 **Election of Mayor and Vice Mayor.**

36 Vice Mayor DiRemigio nominated Councilperson Dennis Wallace to serve as Mayor, seconded
37 by Councilperson Haynes.

39 Vice Mayor DiRemigio closed the nominations. 5 yeas in favor of Councilperson Dennis
40 Wallace as Mayor. Motion carried unanimously.

42 Councilperson Wallace nominated Vice Mayor DiRemigio to serve another term as Vice Mayor.
43 Vice Mayor DiRemigio turned down the nomination and nominated Councilperson Lemasters as

3 Councilperson DiRemigio closed nominations. 5 yeas in favor of Councilperson Wayne
4 Lemasters as Vice Mayor. Motion carried unanimously.

9 Attorney White read the following ordinance by title only to be passed by council on second and
10 final reading:

13 **CREATING SECTION 925 PERTAINING TO THE CONTROL OF BACK FLOW AND**
14 **CROSS CONNECTION PREVENTION PROGRAM. (SECOND READING)**

16 Councilperson Wood made a motion to approve the back flow ordinance, seconded by
17 Councilperson Wallace. Motion carried unanimously.
