The Council of the City of Moundsville met in regular session in the Council Chambers on January 15, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Eugene Saunders.

Invocation by Councilperson Mark Simms.

City Clerk Hewitt called the roll and the following councilpersons were in attendance: DeWitt, D. Haynes, P. Haynes, Remke, Simms, Wood and Mayor Saunders. Regular Council Meeting of January 2, 2013.

Councilperson P. Haynes moved to accept and approve the minutes of the regular council meeting of January 2, 2013, seconded by Councilperson Simms.

GENERAL PUBLIC HEARING:

* Allen Hendershot, 1 Hess Court, provided council with an overview of progress at the Sanford Center reporting that rentals of the community room and gym are going well; a recent donation was received from the Marshall County Commission; a steak fry is scheduled for February 16 in the gym tickets are \$15 per person. The Center is trying to establish a Boys & Girls Club with after school programs.

Councilperson Wood asked Mr. Hendershot if he could meet with the City Manager to renegotiate the lease agreement which has expired. The Policy Committee discussed signing the lease every 5 years instead of yearly.

Councilperson Wood moved to accept and approve the ordinance to abolish the Moundsville Building Commission, seconded by Councilperson Remke.

Mayor Saunders called for a voice vote. City Clerk announced the following tally. D Haynes, P Haynes, Remke, Simms, Wood and Mayor Saunders. 7 yeas. Motion carried unanimously.
