29 **GENERAL PUBLIC HEARING:**

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31 \* Mike Pierson, Treasure Chest, 323 Jefferson Avenue, said he was cited from the City Police for  
32 not filling out pawn cards for property he purchased and must go to Magistrate Court. He  
33 thought council would discuss his issue at the sub committee meetings on November 12, 2013  
34 before any action was taken.

36 \* Micheala Carr, 401 11<sup>th</sup> Street, complained of neighbors garbage problem, their dog using her  
37 yard to do its business and running loose.

39 \* Brad Burrow, 3685 Glen Dale Heights Road, owner/operator Brad's Grateful Doggs,  
40 introduced himself to council and said that he spoke with the City Clerk who informed him that  
41 he would have to put money in the meter, which he said he had been doing. However, there had  
42 been times he was too busy to put money in the meter and if he receives a ticket he will pay it.  
43 He wanted to inform council that he has been putting money in the meter.

1 \* Carl Boso, 305 10<sup>th</sup> Street, commented he feels if somebody is doing business in the City of

18 \* Councilperson Remke reported street needs repaired at 7<sup>th</sup> Street & Baker Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Street  
19 & Ash Avenue.

21 \* Councilperson Remke asked Mayor Saunders for a completion date of the installation of  
22 playground equipment at Park View Playground? Mayor Saunders reported Recreation Director  
23 Baker will have the equipment installed by the end of next week.

25 \* Councilperson Remke reported the tree is still laying on the apartment at 2008 7<sup>th</sup> Street rear.  
26 Building Inspector Richmond reported that he is still working on that issue.

28 \* Councilperson Remke reported illegal vehicles are still parked at 2<sup>nd</sup> Street & Washington  
29 Avenue.
