5 The Council of the City of Moundsville met in special session in the Council 6 Chambers on March 17, 2015 at 6:30 pm.

7

8 Meeting was called to order by Mayor David Wood.

9

- 10 Acting City Clerk Ankrom called the roll and the following Councilpersons
- 11 were in attendance: DeWitt, David Haynes, Paul Haynes, Hendershot, Simms,
- 12 and Mayor Wood. Absent was Vice Mayor Saunders, who was out of town.
- 13 Also present were Acting City Manager Hewitt, Building Inspector Joe
- 14 Richmond, Police Chief Mitchell, and Attorney Thomas White. Absent was City
- 15 Manager Deanna J Hess due to illness.

16

- 17 Consider the Appeal of Vacant Building Registration Code Violation for
- 18 Properties Located at 40 Fostoria Avenue and 203 Parriott Avenue, Owned
- 19 **by H Carl Boso Jr**
- 20 Attorney White explained to Council that there is no particular procedure for 21 an appeal of this kind.

22

- 23 Councilman Hendershot referenced the 30-day time limit to challenge the
- 24 assessment of the fee, as specified in 1107.06 Appeal as to Vacant Building,
- 25 and made a motion to waive the time constraints in order to hear Mr. Boso's
- 26 appeal. Motion was seconded by Councilman David Haynes and carried
- 27 unanimously.

- 29 Inspector Richmond provided summaries of the transfer of ownership for the
- 30 properties at 40 Fostoria Avenue and 203 Parriott Avenue and of work that
- has been done to date, as well as pictures of the exterior and interior of the
- 32 houses.

33

- 34 Mr. Boso repaired the exterior of the houses first, in order to make them
- 35 presentable to the neighborhoods, and is currently working on the interiors,
- 36 as his schedule allows.

37

- 38 Mr. Boso anticipates having 40 Fostoria Avenue ready to rent in about a
- month. He has had new electric service installed, as well as updated water
- 40 and sewer lines. This house has alley-access parking.

41

- 42 Discussion was held on revising the existing Ordinance in order to give the
- 43 Building Inspectors more flexibility to work with homeowners who are
- 44 attempting to repair their properties. Council was in agreement that waiving

1	the fees gives property owners more income to invest in their properties.
2	
3	Councilman Simms made a motion to grant a six month extension on 40
4	Fostoria Avenue and 203 Parriott Avenue. Councilman Paul Haynes seconded
5	the motion, which carried unanimously. Mr. Boso will give an update in six
6	months, if both properties are not completed by that time.
7	
8	Councilman Hendershot made a motion to adjourn, which Councilman Simms
9	seconded. Hearing adjourned at 6:50 PM.
